ENHANCED ENTRY POINT FOR ENGINEERS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE

Sequel to the decision of the National Council on Establishments (NCE), at its 40th meeting and consequent issuance of the Federal Circular No. HCSF/SPSO/ODD/NCE/CND.100/S.8/T/38 dated 11th December, 2018 on the above subject, the State Government has considered and graciously approved the adoption of SGL.09 as the entry point for graduate Engineers into the Public Service and after successful completion of the prescribed two (2) years pupillage programme, shall be advanced to SGL.10.

- 2. Accordingly, XX Engineers that were employed as Pupil XX Engineer on SGL.08 and are still on SGL.08 as at date, are to be advanced to XX Engineer I, GL.09. In the same vein, officers that were employed based on Master's degree certificate on SLG.09, and are still on SGL.09 as at date are to be advanced to Senior XX Engineer, GL.10.
- 3. While noting that this will be reflected in the subsequent edition of the Schemes of Service, this circular takes effect from 1st August, 2021.
- 4. Kindly ensure that this is circularised to all concerned.
