TO: ALL LOCAL GOVERNMENT CHAIRMEN

Participation by Tramitional Rulers in National Assignments

I am directed to refer to your discussions with the Director-General on the above subject on Wednesday, 3rd October, 1990.

- 2. It would be observed that at one time or the other, some traditional rulers in the State had been invited to participate in National Assignments outside the State on matters relating to grass-root developments directly beneficial to their Local Governments. From experience, some of the traditional rulers were unable to attend such assignments, in some cases' due to lack of funds.
- 3. In order to enhance further participation of our traditional rulers in such National Assignments outside the State, it has been considered necessary that henceforth, Chairmen of Local Governments should make available appropriate touring advances for such assignments.
- 4. Meanwhile, attached to this Circular is the list of Obas selected to participate in the "Peoples Forum" scheduled to take place at Tafawa Balewa Square, Lagos on Tuesday, 9th October, 1990 as one of the activities lined up to mark the one Year Anniversary of 'The People's Bank of Nigeria.' The Obas are expected to leave for Lagos on Monday, 8th October, 1990. A touring advance of N1,500.00 N2,000.00 should be made available urgently to each of the Obas for the Lagos journey.
