## RE: REQUEST FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF CAREER PROGRESSION OF OFFICERS ON GL. 16 OR GL. 17 IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE

The Head of Service has observed with dismay the recent trend in which officers that have gotten to the position of Director, GL. 16 or GL. 17, are now requesting for reconstruction of their career progression.

- 2. In the Civil Service, appointment, conversion and promotion goes through a process that involves the Senior Management Committee and plenary sittings of the Commission and therefore not automatic.
- 3. Often times, there might be complains from officers but it is expected that such officers, especially Senior Management Officers should have settled all issues relating to career construction before attaining the very peak of the Civil Service Career structure. Even in the court of law, an individual is expected to appeal a case within a stipulated period, failure to do so, the person has lost his/her right of appeal after which such cases could no longer be prosecuted i.e. statute barred.
- 4. Records have shown that some officers had either disciplinary issues or failed promotion examinations and as such were not promoted within such periods. Thus being left behind by their colleagues or overtaken by their subordinates.
- 5. It is, therefore, absurd that officers that have gotten to the bar in their career are now requesting for career reconstruction after many years. To this end, I wish to state that the state government would not entertain requests for career reconstruction from substantive Directors, GL. 16 or GL. 17 in the Public Service.
- 6. All Accounting Officers are enjoined to give the contents of this circular the publicity it deserves, please.
