## ESTABLISHMENT OF ODSC/UN-HABITAT URBAN OBSERVATORY IN ONDO STATE

## DEPLOYMENT OF STAFF

In furtherance of the 2013 agreement between the United Nations Human Settlements Programme [UN-Habitat] and Ondo State Government, a local urban observatory known as the Ondo State Urban Observatory is to be established in the State.
