MIGRATION FROM MANUAL TO ELECTRONIC PROCESSING OF BENCHMARK PRICE

The vision of Ondo State Bureau of Public Procurement is to deliver value to its various stakeholders through wholesale digitalization of procurement processes. Consequently, we have developed for state wide utilization, an electronic portal which will enable ODBPP fast tract requests for price benchmark. The automation of this process signposts ODBPP's linkage with the REDEEMED agenda of Governor Oluwarotimi Akeredolu's administration.

- Henceforth, with effect from 30th April, 2022, request for benchmark price should be forwarded electronically using the ODBPP web portal with the following address (<https://ebenchmarking.org>). The password for each MDA has been forwarded to the officers nominated for the e-benchmarking training. However, MDAs who are not able to attend the scheduled training sessions earlier organized would be given the second chance to attend the final training sessions scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday 27th and 28th April, 2022 respectively by 10am.

- It is pertinent to state that all manual requests for benchmark will be declined with effect from 30th April, 2022.
