Further to my circular letter with reference number SC.563/10 dated 11th April, 2022 on the above subject matter, I wish to reiterate that the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, His Excellency Muhammadu Buhari (GCFR) has signed the amended Electoral Bill into Law and the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) has released guidelines on the conduct of the impending general elections thereby signaling the commencement of intense political activities both at the Federal and State levels.
